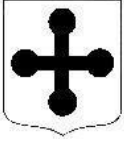

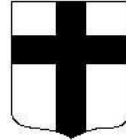

Dear people of WWW

For the next four Sunday's the readings are concentrated around eating and Jesus as the bread of heaven.

This week the gospel reading finishes with Jesus saying, "I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never be hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty." (John 6.35)

While in the Old Testament God provides manna from heaven for the recently freed Israelites. The following week, my second favourite prophet, good old Elijah, has thrown in the towel and finds that while he has given up, God has not given up on him, and God provides a meal for him so he can get back on track, and walk back out of the wilderness. The gospel finds the people complaining that Jesus said "I am the bread that came down from heaven" and "I am the bread of life. Your ancestors ate the manna in the wilderness, and they died. This is the bread that comes down from heaven. Whoever eats of this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give for the life of the world is my flesh." (John 6.41 & 51)

I am looking forward to exploring these concepts, I think we can ascertain that God knows what we need, both on a very basic level in regard to "our daily bread" and

also eternally-“ Lord I do not know  
the way to where you are going!”
