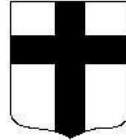

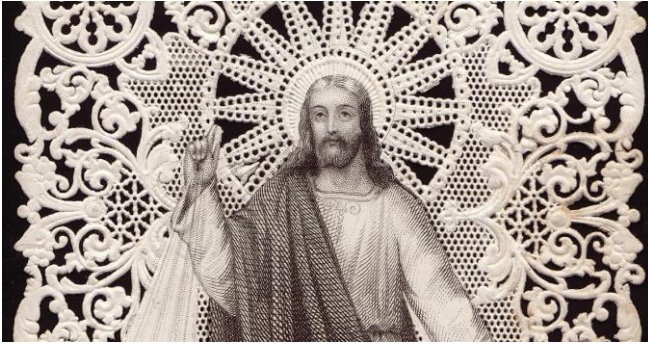

As we celebrate Christ the King this Sunday and leave behind the Ordinary Sunday's until next year let us reflect on that season in Ordinary time, perhaps is not so ordinary at all!
